The Animal Control Bylaw was given first reading on May 4, 2010. This bylaw allows residents to have up to 5 laying hens. A copy of the Bylaw is available for pick up at the Town Office. Any comments or questions on this bylaw will be accepted until May 25.

The Town does allow off-highway vehicles to be driven on a public road as long as they are taking the most direct route out of Town, driving at a reasonable speed in a safe and courteous manner and does not cause a disturbance to other residents.
