(a) Tax Cancellations – 5107 – 50 Street

The Parks Society has been approved for a grant of \$22,000 for a Skateboard Park.

- -this is a matching grant
- -the Parks Society has approximately \$15,000 in the bank and they hope to make Approximately \$6,000 at the Halloween dance.

Jaime Burghardt reported that a person that works with Park inspections looked at the Parks in Town and noted that they are in poor shape and could be a liability.

Ukraina Park

-The play area needs to be fixed up as things are broken

Victory Park

- -the sand should be rototilled yearly
- -better signage is required depicting what age groups the pay equipment caters to
- -the height of the tirewall should have a sign stating ages 12 and over
- -bolts are protruding on the tire play area
- -the bolts and the seat need to be replaced on the swings
- -there is a gap in the slide that is a choking hazard
- -12 inches of sand needed
- -wood chips could be spread over the ground to act as a cushion

-the rubber is wearing down on the tires and could easily break down

Discussion took place and the Tire wall will be taken down due to safety concerns
