Delegation

Garry Cooper and Peter and Janice Butt were present to discuss the Whitetail Crossing playground.

Excavation has already begun for the playground

- they were not given any notification of a playground being installed behind their property
- -felt it is a very small area for a playground
- -concerned that it may reduce property values
- -thought it was designated as greenspace not a playground
- -requested that the playground be moved to the north
- -feel that majority of the children are in the east part of the development
- -mentioned that they would be willing to help cover costs of moving the playground

Council will consult with surrounding landowners and get feedback on where they think the playground should go.

Public Works will stake out an area 50ft further to the North for review

Rosypal that a decision on the location of the playground be tabled to a future meeting to allow time for Public Works to stake out the area and look at options.

Financial

(a) Ukraina Park Sewer Issue

The sewer line from the park through the grotto is only a 4 inch line. With heavy use, the paper collects in the line and backs up.

The solution to the problem would be to install a septic tank, at the manhole location, that would allow effluent to be pumped into the sewer line and the solids be cleaned out when required.

(b) Playground – Quentin Warawa Park

A junior playground structure will be built at the Quentin Warawa Memorial Park. The Parks Society is donating funds for the Junior Playground.

Rosypal that a playground for the Quentin Warawa Memorial Park be added to the 2016 budget in the amount of \$12,000.

(c)Whitetail Crossing Playground

Quotes have been received for engineered wood fibre for the Whitetail Crossing Playground.

The costs for the Quentin Warawa Memorial Park and Whitetail Crossing Playgrounds are \$9,735 versus \$8,975 just for the Whitetail Crossing. There are savings for trucking costs. The Parks Society will pay for the fibre for the Quentin Warawa Memorial Park.

<u>Talaga</u> that the Town add \$8,000 to the 2016 budget for the engineered wood fibre for the Whitetail Crossing Playground.

A Wheel Loader has been purchased.
