Bylaw 874/16

The Council of the Town of Mundare properly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw is known as the "2016 Mill Rate Bylaw".
- 2. Detailed estimates of the town revenue and expenditures were adopted at the council meeting held May 17, 2016.
- 3. The estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for 2016 total \$2,979,405.
- The estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$1,811,905 and the balance of \$1,167,500 is to be raised by general municipal taxation.
- 5. The 2016 requisitions are:
