LIBRARY NEWS

Mundare Municipal Public Library will be open to the public on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

One patron at a time will be allowed to enter the library. Sanitizer, gloves and masks will be provided if you need.

Pick-up will continue: Patrons with items for pick up will be notified by telephone. Items will be left on the table, at the entrance to the Town of Mundare building, for zero contact pick-up. Pick -ups are available Monday to Friday, during the Town of Mundare office hours.

Van Run items will arrive on Thursdays and will be quarantined and available on Tuesdays.

located near the library entrance (at the back of the Mundare Town Office building). Returned items will be guarantined for 72 hours, checked in, and put back on the shelves or in the van run.
