### **TOWN OF MUNDARE**

## **BYLAW NO. 932/21**

The Council of the Town of Mundare properly assembled enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw is to be cited as the "Assessment Review Board Bylaw".

#### **Definitions**

# 2. In this Bylaw:

- a. "Act" means the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A 2000, c. M-26, as amended.
- b. "Assessment Review Board" means either the Local Assessment Review Board or the Composite Assessment Review Board.
- c. "Clerk" means the designated officer appointed by Council to carry out the powers, duties and functions of the Assessment Review Board Clerk, pursuant to the Act.
- d. "Complaint" means a complaint about any assessment or tax relating to any assessed property or business within the Town, made in accordance with and under Part 11 of the Act.
- e. "Composite Assessment Review Board" (CARB) means the Composite Assessment Review Board established by this Bylaw to hear complaints referred to in section 460.1(2) of the Act.
- f. "Local Assessment Review Board" (LARB) means the Local Assessment Review Board established by this Bylaw to hear complaints referred to in section 460.1(1) of the Act.
- g. "Member" means a member of the Local Assessment Review Board or the Composite Assessment Review Board appointed pursuant to this Bylaw.

## **Establishment of Boards**

- 3. The following Assessment Review Boards are hereby established to have jurisdiction in the Town:
  - a. Local Assessment Review Board (LARB); and
  - b. Composite Assessment Review Board (CARB).

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### ARB Clerk

- 4. Council shall by resolution appoint a person as the clerk of the Assessment Review Board.
- 5. In addition to those duties prescribed in the Act and regulations passed thereunder, the Clerk shall have the following functions and duties:
  - a. maintain a record of current Members;
  - b. ensure that all statutory requirements of the LARB and CARB are met;
  - c. compile necessary documentation for distribution to the Members;
  - d. attend all LARB and CARB hearings.
  - e. such other matters as the Local Assessment Review Board or the Composite Assessment Review Board may direct.
- 6. Council shall by resolution determine the amount of remuneration payable to the ARB Clerk.

### **MEMBERS**

- 7. Council shall appoint at least three persons as Members of the LARB and at least two persons as Members of the CARB.
- 8. Members may be appointed for one or more additional consecutive terms.
- 9. No person who is an employee or councillor of the Town shall be appointed as a Member.
- 10. A Member ceases to be a Member if:
  - a. the Member becomes an employee of or a councillor for the Town;
  - b. the Member fails to comply with the pecuniary interest provisions in section 480 of the Act; or
  - c. the Member's appointment to Assessment Review Board is rescinded by a resolution of Council.
- 11. If a Member resigns or ceases to be a Member, Council may at any time appoint a replacement Member for the remainder of the term.
- 12. Council shall by resolution determine the amount of remuneration and expenses payable to Members.

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### Chair

- 13. Council shall by resolution appoint a Member as Chair of the Assessment Review Board.
- 14. Council shall by resolution determine the amount of remuneration and expenses payable to the Chair.

# **COMING INTO FORCE AND REPEAL**

- 15. Should any provision of this Bylaw be invalid, then such provision shall be severed, and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.
- 16. That Bylaw No. 849/13-A and all subsequent amendments are hereby repealed.
