If a property is determined to be unsightly, a notice is sent to the landowner

-the notice will explain the what needs to be done and the date by which the work must be completed After the due date, an inspection is carried out.

If the work is not completed, a contractor is hired to do the work.

-the owner is charged all the contractor costs plus an administration fee of \$75

-if the invoice is not paid, the amount is added to the taxes
