

While names of board members are public information, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses are for the use of the Public Library Service Branch only and are not made available to the public.

Questions on Board Member responsibilities can be directed to Lillian Sabo by emailing asabo@mcsnet.ca **Memberships and renewals** are available during library hours. Arrangements can be made to renew a membership by calling the library manager during library hours if patrons are not able to come to the library during operational hours.

Library fees are as follows:

\$10 Adult; \$7 Senior; \$25 Family; \$5 Children Cash only

The library manager is on hand to help patrons access items using TRAC or the website and to provide reading suggestions. Reading recommendations from patrons are welcomed.
