No we do NOT accept grass clippings or yard debris, those need to go in your grey bin, we do however take branches, and trees, small electronics & batteries.


If you need the key, please stop into the town office Monday-Friday between the hours of 9 and 4:30. NO KEY will be given out over night or over the weekend.


