Property Taxes

There is a 5% discount on the municipal portion of your taxes if prepaid by January 31, 2023. A Monthly installment payment program is also available if your account is in good standing. Forms are available at the town office. A 10% Penalty will be added to any outstanding taxes as of January 1, 2023. Contact the town office for details.

All Animal Licenses are now due ! Please come to the office to renew your licenses before January 31. Dog License are \$15.00 and a Cat License are \$5.00 each. Puppies must be licensed after 6 months of age


