# 2025 Town Tax Notices

Tax notices will be in the mail soon, if you have not received your notice by June 30, please contact us.

Any person who objects to the assessment value placed upon a property must lodge their complaint (s) on the prescribed form with a \$50 fee. Please note, if making a complaint, your property taxes still need to be paid by the due date or subject to a 10% penalty.

Property Taxes are due and payable on or before July 31. Please note a 10% penalty will be applied August 1, 2025. Please contact the town if you are unsure on how you can pay.
