Animal Control

Our peace officer would like to remind everyone that cats/dogs are not to be off leash in the town of Mundare.

Cat licenses are \$5.00 a year dog licenses are \$15.00, and due every January, even if your cat is an indoor cat. Fines for non licensed animal is \$75.00 No domestic animal shall cause damage to property other than the owners property. le. Animal urinating or defecating on another persons property or digging up plants.

Fines for animals at large (off leash) is \$250

Effective September 1, 2025, Prairie Waste Solutions will be our new contractor for residential garbage collection and Quest Management and Recycling Inc. for commercial front load bin garbage collection. We are currently working with the contractors to plan the switch over and will provide more information in the future
