2025 Tax Notices

Tax Notices were sent out in June, if you have not received your tax notice, please contact us immediately. Taxes are due July 31, 2025. Assessment roll is available for inspection at the Town office.

Any person who objects to the assessment value placed upon a property must lodge their complaint (s) on the prescribed form by August 18, 2025 with a \$50 fee. Property taxes are due and payable on or before July 31. Please note a 10% penalty will be applied August 1, 2025.
