Our peace officer would like to remind everyone that cats/dogs are not to be off leash in the Town of Mundare and are not aloud in parks, only exception is the dog park..

Cat licenses are \$5.00 a year, and dog licenses are \$15.00, and due every January, even if your cat is an indoor cat. Fines for non licensed animal is \$75.00 No domestic animal shall cause damage to property other than the owners property. Ie. Animal urinating or defecating on another persons property or digging up plants.

**Fines for animals at large (off leash) is \$250**
